Submission of Abstract

Abstract Submission Guidelines:

The faculty members, researchers, students and early career academicians are invited to submit **Abstracts of not more than 300 words**. The abstract should include the **Title of the Paper** (Times New Roman, 14 pt, **Bold, Centre Aligned**), **Full name of the Author(s)** (Times New Roman, 12 pt, **Bold, Centre Aligned**), **Affiliation(s)** (Department, Institution and E-mail address of all authors), **Conference Sub-theme**, and **4–6 Keywords**. Abstracts can be submitted both in English and Bengali (Bengali Font: Avro or Kalpurush).

The abstract must be prepared in **Times New Roman, 12 pt**, with **1.5 line spacing** and **justified alignment**. Authors should clearly indicate their **preferred mode of presentation (Oral/Poster)** and submit the abstract in both **Microsoft Word (.doc/.docx)** and **PDF (.pdf)** formats.

Registration Process & Fee

Abstracts must be submitted through the **Google Form** on or before **10th August, 2026 (11.59 pm)**, along with the **SB Collect Payment Receipt** and put the **SB Collect Ref. No. Certificates of Participation** will be issued to all registered participants upon successful participation in the conference. Outstanding Oral/Poster presentations will be awarded.

Step by Step Procedure for Registration Fee Deposit through SBI Collect

1. Visit the SBI Collect portal:

2. On the home page, select **Education Institutions** as the category.

3. Search for **University of Kalyani A/C SBC** and select it.
